Capability	Description of Capability	<b>Costs or Fees</b> <i>Types of costs or fees that a user may be required to pay to purchase, license, implement, maintain, upgrade, use, or otherwise enable and support the use of the implementation or use of the capability -OR- in connection with the data generated in the course using the capability</i>	<b>Contractual Limitations</b> <i>Limitations of a contractual nature (including developer policies and other business practices) that a user may encounter in the implementation or use of the capability -OR- in the connection with the data generated in the course of using the capability</i>	<b>Technical or Practical Limitations</b> <i>Limitations of a technical or practical nature that a user may encounter that could prevent or impair the successful implementation, configuration, maintenance, support or use of the capability -OR- prevent or limit the use, exchange or portability of any data generated in the course of using the capability</i>
Protect Electronic Protected Health Information	Protect electronic protected health information (ePHI) created or maintained by the CEHRT through the implementation of appropriate technical capabilities. For accurate reporting of MU/ACI, interfaces with the EMR are required.  For patients to securely transmit their health information to another provider outside of the practice, the practice must enable DIRECT support using Data Motion's HISP and external providers must have DIRECT addresses.
Electronic Access	Provide patients the ability to view online, download and transmit their health information within the required time period of the information being available to the EP.			
Patient Education	Use clinically relevant information from Certified EHR Technology to identify patient-specific education resources and provide those resources to the patient.			
Secure Messaging	Enable secure messaging to communicate with patients on relevant health information.
