



Navigating Cancer (NC) supports exporting patient electronic health information (EHI) for either a single patient or all patients at a clinic. The format of these exports are as follows:

- Single-patient exports are aggregated into a single zip folder structure per patient
- All-patient exports are aggregated into a directory containing a single zip folder for each patient
- The zip file naming convention is 'electronic\_health\_information.zip'
- The set of possible zip file contents and formats are:
  - Appointments (.json)
  - Billing Events (.json)
  - Clinical Documents (.json)
  - Distress Survey Submission (.json)
  - Distress Depression Survey Submission (.json)
  - Distress Pain Survey Submission (.json)
  - Health Tracker Check Ins (.json)
  - Health Tracker Check Enrollments (.json)
  - High Risk Status (.json)
  - Patient Home Care Instructions (.json)
  - EHR Lab Attachments (.json)
  - Patient Insurance (.json)
  - Patient Task Note (.json)
  - Patient Triage Tickets (.json)
  - Patient Health Submission (.json)
  - Secure Messages (.json)
  - Consolidated Clinical Document (.xml CCDA version R2.1)
- Each file listed above is in a designated subfolder of the zip file and within each is a README.txt file that provides field-level data type information for each file (except for CCDA.
